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This section asks for information about the work that you have submitted for publication. The requested information is about resources that you received, either directly or indirectly (via your institution), to enable you to complete the work. For example, if a government agency sponsored a study in which you have been involved and drugs were provided by a pharmaceutical company, you need only list the pharmaceutical company.
